1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by:
 - a. The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
 - b. The Snipe Class Rules
 - c. The National Anti-Doping rule 2007
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P will NOT apply.
- 1.3. RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.4. RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.5. RRS 30.4 will not be used.
- 1.6. RRS 32.2 and 33 will be changed to limit course changes.
- 1.7. RRS 60.1(a) will be changed to restrict protest from boats for specific items on the NoR and SI.
- 1.8. RRS 64.2 will be changed to compel the Jury/PC to abandon a race as required by RoC 18.
- 1.9. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Advertising is permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 2.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. All competitors shall be members of Austrian Sailing Federation or any other World Sailing member national authority.
- 3.2. Regatta is open to registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews in good standing with Snipe Class for the current year, subject to any Deed of Gift restrictions.

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fees: EUR 70,-. Late entries (after May 29th.): EUR 90
- 4.2. Payment in cash during the registration on site
- 4.3. Registration should be completed on site within Saturday June 03, 2023 at 11:00

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Registration:
June 03 from hrs 10:00
Skippers meeting:
June 03 hrs 11:00
- 5.2. Schedule of Regatta Races:
June 03 hrs 13:00 1. Possible warning signal race #1, following races as in S.I.
June 04 time for the warning signal of the first race of the day will be announced June 03
Last possible warning signal the June 04 – 15:00
- 5.3. Prize giving ceremony as soon as possible after the last race
- 5.4. No more than four (4) races shall be sailed per day. Five (5) races are scheduled. Target time 50 min. One (1) race must be completed to constitute the “Alpen Grand Prix”.

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1. All boats must have effective measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- 6.2. All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Office during registration.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. The sailing area is located in front of Segelclub Mattsee on Lake Mattsee.
- 8.2. Car Park: Weyerbucht Strasse.
- 8.3. Boat park and launching ramp: private area next to Weyerbrucht Strasse1, 5163 Mattsee. Clubhouse; few minute walking distance through Schlossbergweg.
- 8.4. Regatta office and Notice Board are located at the Clubhouse.

9. COURSES

- 9.1. The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses. More details on the Sailing Instruction

10. SCORING

- 10.1. The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.
- 10.2. If 4 or 5 races are completed, the worst race shall be dropped, including a disqualification.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance by at least Eur 1.500.000 worth. Proof of insurance shall be provided upon registration.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing or receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 12.2. This restriction applies to mobile telephones.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1. Prizes for the top 3 places.
- 14.2. Prize Giving ceremony will take place on Saturday evening.

15. MEDIA RIGHTS

- 15.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recording, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
Photo: Organization may take pictures during the regatta or social events. They will be provided to sailors and for press purpose.
Data/privacy: All the data collected by the Mattsee Sailing club are related to the Venue management and won't be provided to any third party Authority.
